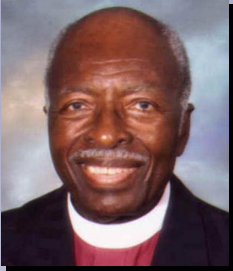

With this dream in mind, this year's conference has been tailored into a format and style conducive to what is labeled as a "Holy Convocation" Old Testament time of interaction and fellowship.

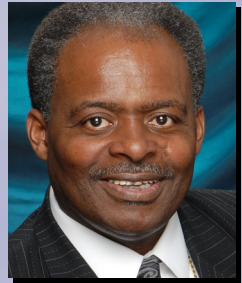
